- Qualifications are as per First Statutes of Chaudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut and as per UGC Regulations 2018 dated 18 July 2018 and U.P. Govt. Notification dated 28 June 2019 (for University Teachers).
- The prescribed application fee (Rs. 1000/- for UR, OBC & Rs. 750/- for SC & EWS candidates) is to be paid online.
- Printout of online application form duly completed in all respects along with self attested documents is to be submitted by Registered/Speed post addressed to the **Registrar, Chaudhary Charan Singh University, Meerut (U.P.) – 250004, India**. It is mandatory to mention Advertisement No., Post, Subject and Category.
- Applicants should clearly note that the University will, in no case, be responsible for non submission of their completed applications within time. Applications submitted after the last date shall not be entertained.
- Mere eligibility will not entitle any candidate to be called for the interview.
- Reservations will be applicable as per U.P. State Government norms/rules. Other states OBC/SC/ST/EWS candidates would be treated as General Category candidates.

**ELIGIBILITY & OTHER RELEVANT PROVISIONS FOR RECRUITMENT**

**1.1 General Eligibility Criteria for Assistant Professor**

- 1.1.1 Good academic record as defined by the State Government with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- 1.1.2 Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- 1.1.3 Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-clauses (1.1.1) and (1.1.2) to this Clause, candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.
- 1.1.4 NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.

**1.2. General Eligibility Criteria for Associate Professor**

- 1.2.1 Good academic record with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant disciplines.
- 1.2.2 A Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).
- 1.2.3 A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor/Lecturer in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/Industry excluding the period of Ph.D. research with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
- 1.2.4 Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology – mediated teaching learning process with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates and research students.

**1.3. General Eligibility Criteria for Professor**

- 1.3.1 Good academic record with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant disciplines.
- 1.3.2 An eminent scholar with Ph.D. qualification(s) in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
- 1.3.3 A minimum of ten years experience in university/college, and/or experience in research at the University/National level institutions/industries, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
- 1.3.4 Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology-mediated teaching learning process.



## 2. Other Relevant Provisions for Recruitment

- 2.1 A minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) will be required at the Master's degree level with good academic record for those candidates to be recruited as teachers at any level from industries and research institutions and at the entry level of Assistant Professor. Provided that a relaxation of 5% may be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.
- 2.2 The minimum requirements of a good academic record is Second Division at Graduate degree level, 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the master's degree level and qualifying in the National Eligibility Test (NET), or an accredited test (State Level Eligibility Test - SLET/SET), shall remain for the appointment of Assistant Professor.
- 2.3 A relaxation of 5% shall be provided at the graduate and master's degree level for the posts reserved for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Differently-abled (Physically and visually differently-abled) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.
- 2.4 Relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55% wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized university shall also be considered eligible.
- 2.5 The Ph.D. Degree shall be a mandatory qualification for the appointment of Professor and Associate Professor.
- 2.6 The period of time taken by candidates to acquire M.Phil. and/or Ph.D. Degree shall not be considered as teaching/research experience to be claimed for appointment to the teaching positions.
- 2.7 The Selection Committee specifications as provided in section 31 of the Act are applicable to all direct recruitments of faculty positions.
- 2.8 Percentage equivalence of grade points for a seven points scale: Where the University/College/Institution declare results in grade points which is on a scale of seven, the following mechanism shall be referred to ascertain equivalent marks in percentage:  
A-Under UGC norms -

Grade	Grade Point	Percentage Equivalent
'O' - Outstanding	5.50-6.00	75-100
'A' - Very Good	4.50-5.49	65-74
'B' - Good	3.50-4.49	55-64
'C' - Average	2.50-3.49	45-54

'E' - Poor	0.50-1.49	25-34
'F' - Fail	0-0.49	0-24

If a class /division is not awarded, minimum of 60% marks in aggregate shall be considered equivalent to first class/ division.
