Applications are invited from highly motivated and eligible candidates for the position of Project assistants (PA) in a NTPC funded Research Project entitled "Development of electrodes and design of a prototype for the Hard/Sea water electrolysis".

Number of Positions: One

Eligibility

Essential Qualification:

(i) M.Sc. degree in Chemistry with minimum 60% marks or 6.0 CPI on a 10 point scale

or

(ii) M.Tech. degree in Chemical Engineering minimum 60% marks or 6.0 CPI on a 10 point scale

or

(iii) B.Tech. degree in Chemical Engineering minimum 75% marks or 7.5 CPI on a 10 point scale, for candidates with more than 2 years of experience the minimum requirement is 70% marks or 7.0 CPI on a 10 point scale provided the degree is from an Institution funded by central government

Age: Upper age limit is 28 years with 5 years' relaxation for female/SC/ST/PH candidates

Experience: Candidates with prior experience in synthesis of nanoparticles, microscopic analysis and electrochemistry etc would be given preference.

Stipend: Candidates those are GATE qualified: Rs. 31000/- per month (Consolidated)

Candidates without GATE qualification: Rs. 16000/- per month (Consolidated)

Duration: The initial appointment will be for one year, which is extendable further till the end of project, solely based on performance. Hostel accommodation will be provided on payment of applicable charges.

Only shortlisted candidates will be called for interview. Shortlisted candidates will be intimated via e-mail about the date of interview. No TA/DA will be paid for appearing in the interview and candidates will be provided accommodation for the interview process.
