Chief Medical Superintendent, Mumbai Division, Western Railway will be conducting Walk in interview at 10.30 hrs on 08/05/2025 at Chief Medical Superintendent Office, Mumbai Central for filling-up the posts of Contract Medical Practitioners on full-time contract basis up to period of one year.

For GDMOs & Specialists from open market

The engagement will be offered purely on contract basis for a period of one year or less from the date of contract, which can be renewed as a fresh contract on year to year basis, not extendable beyond 12 terms or till attaining the age of 65 years or till such time Doctors selected by UPSC become available, whichever is earlier.

The maximum age for first time engagement is 53 years and maximum age limit for re-engagements is 65 years or completion of 12 terms, whichever is earlier. Each term of engagement shall not exceed more than one year. For Retired / Government doctors, maximum age limit is 67 years and 07 terms.

Educational / Professional Qualifications

For GDMO-

1. Degree in medicine i.e. MBBS recognized by the Medical Council of India. Candidates must be registered with MCI / MMC

Reservation for the post will be as per recruitment rules.

Retired Govt. Medical Officers of State Government and Central Government Doctors up to the age of 67 years may apply for CMP against existing regular vacancies on remuneration subject to the condition remuneration plus pension drawn by Retired government doctors should not exceed the last pay drawn.

Candidates should have requisite academic qualification on the date of interview. Those who are appearing at and / or awaiting results of final examination are not eligible. Academic and Technical qualification must be from are cognized Institution/ Board, otherwise candidature will be rejected.

Candidates has to undergo medical examination before confirmation of posting.

The vacancies indicated may vary in number and place, depending on fresh sanctions received, resignations being given by existing candidates, etc.

Post indicated herein may be kept unfilled at the discretion of administration.

Terms and condition

- 1. The contract shall be entered into for one year or less from the date of entering into the contract. Period of contract is not extendable on any grounds. However, the Railway administration shall reserve the right to enter into fresh contract with the Medical Practitioner for another term.
- 2. The full time contracted Medical Practitioner (herein after referred to as CMP), who enters into contract with the railways will not have any claim or right for his/her continuity in service or automatic extension of the term of contract.
- 3. CMP can tender resignation by giving a 15 day notice. Administration can also terminate a CMP by issuing a 15 day notice. However in exceptional circumstances due to exigencies of service and administrative interest a CMP may be terminated with immediate effect. In such cases of immediate termination/resignation, honorarium equal to balance period of notice shall be payable to CMP or shall be recoverable from CMP as the case may be. Termination or acceptance of resignation shall be done with approval of DRM / CWM (SAG) / MD-Zonal Hospital. Contract shall also be terminated, if the CMP is found to be mentally or physically incapacitated or found with doubtful integrity.
- 4. The CMP shall have to undergo a brief orientation for a period of two weeks.
- 5. Normally, Sundays and National Holidays will be off but he will be available for attending any emergency duties.

Any CMP leaving his place of work on leave of absence /National Holidays/ Sundays should get prior permission of the controlling authority.

- 6. The CMP may avail of free medical treatment for self only except the operations categorized as "Special" in para 622 (8) of Indian Railway Medical Manual 2000 and treatment normally available at super specialty centers from his/her respective zonal railway hospital during the currency of contract.
- 7. The CMP shall be governed in respect of matters not referred to in these terms and conditions by any orders/amendments to the terms of contract issued by the Railways from time to time.
- 8. The CMP shall attend to all normal tasks, which any medical practitioner is conventionally doing including duties in Casualty, ICU & OT. CMP duties also include attending station and train emergency calls and accidents. Among those above, appropriate duty list would be provided by CMS/Medical Officer In-Charge of the Division/Hospital at the time of appointment. CMP should be remaining available to attend emergencies if any at all times. CMP is entitled for 02 days leave for each completed month of duty.
- 9. The CMP shall issue sick/fitness/duty certificates for a period up to 7 days, beyond which the certificate so issued by him / her should be countersigned by a regular Railway Medical Officer available at the nearest Hospital/Dispensary / Health Unit.
- 10. The CMP shall not perform administrative work like pre employment or periodical medical examinations, sanction of leave to Group 'C' and 'D' staff and certification with respect to food items considered unfit for human consumption etc. However, the CMP shall be allowed to permit Group 'C' and 'D' staff Casual Leave, If sought for 03 days or less at a stretch.
- 11. The CMP shall not make medical recommendation of any kind referred to Para559 to 564 of Indian Railway Medical Manual (IRMM) 2000, which are reproduced below:
- 12. The CMP will not have any financial powers, however, he/she may operate the impress account in accordance with the guidelines contained in the IRMM. However, the cash vouchers in such cases shall be got countersigned by an authorized Railway Medical Officer. No cash impress account shall be recouped unless the proposal is countersigned by an Indian Railway Medical Service Officer.
- 13. The CMP shall not initiate/review/accept the annual confidential reports of Group "C" railway employees. However, he/she shall, on request, prepare and present the performance report of the staff.
- 14. The CMP shall not indent or condemn/recommend for condemnation any tools and plants.

- 15. The doctor selected should not perform/involve in any activities that would be considered against the interest of Medical Department / Railways and, if found, his/her services will be terminated immediately.
- 16. Remuneration- Consolidated remuneration as per Instructions issued by Railway Boards time to time will be payable to the CMPs.

There will be daily proportionate reduction from the remuneration in the event the CMP absent himself/herself for periods exceeding those stipulated in the contract

- 17. Expenses on outstation journeys connected with the contracted works will be borne by the Railway. Duty passes will be issued by the Railways for the purpose of journey in the line jurisdiction of the Health Unit, where the CMP renders service and to the Divisional Headquarters and the CMP will be paid a fixed rate of Daily Allowance as per Rly. Bds. guidelines. This will be subject to fulfillment of other provisions pertaining to Dally Allowance prescribed in IREC
- 18. The CMP shall also not been titled to any benefit like Pension, Gratuity, Seniority Promotion etc or any other benefits available to Railway Officers appointed through UPSC.
- 19. The CMP may be given one set of First Class complimentary pass for self and family during each contract. The pass, however, shall be issued after he/ she renders three months of contracted service regularly.
- 20. No Railway Privilege passes/PTO shall be admissible to Retired Railway Doctors engaged as CMP's in his/her capacity as CMP.
- 21. The CMPs shall be governed in respect of matters not referred to in these terms and conditions by any orders/amendments to the terms contract issued by the Railways from time to time.
- 22. If selected they have to report for duty within one week.
